JANUARY 2020 BY PACO RITTER

1/16/20 meeting call to order by President Mitchell at 6:18pm. Motion to accept minutes of last meeting made/seconded by Corey/Sean. Motion passed, minutes are now cast in stone.

Discussion of our most prominent subject, our hog situation. Corey and Susie were going to try the human hair spreading trick to see if that would deter the hogs from having a field day on our field.

We plan to stockpile a load or two of dirt to use as needed to curtail the damage done as soon as the weather will permit us to get the dirt. That might be August the way this rain is hitting us now!

Discussion of perhaps using some wolf urine, another proposed remedy for running off the hogs.

The Corps has bought a big hog trap and has successfully used it so far that we know, two batches of several hogs have been captured. Our field still has tremendous damage in several areas but for the past two or three weeks, no new damage seems to have surfaced. We are hoping that the trap has made a significant difference in the population so that it will keep them away from our area.

Our next big topic of discussion was the increase of our dues for the 2020/2021 dues year. Currently we pay \$100 yearly. We have 32 members of which only about 25 are full dues paying members.

Our expenditures far exceeds our intake every year and it has for the past several years. We survive by having our swap meet and fly in every year plus the past few years we've gained extra due to former members passing away and we liquidate their hobby related items at our swap meet and do it on the halves.

We are attempting to move in to the 21st century on our finances and get our dues up to where we are break even on money without outside sources contributing to stay in the black. With that being said, a motion was made and seconded to raise dues to \$185 per year, which is our break even point. The motion was tabled until next meeting. Discussion and vote will be made at our February meeting on how much our dues will be raised and make it official by being in the newsletter and informing ALL MEMBERS who can voice your opinion and your vote to attend the February meeting.

In addition to dues increase, approval of this year's budget is in order. The only major increase is for field maintenance from \$300 to \$800 which became necessary due to the hog damage. The motion was made and seconded by Sean and Paco, it passed. The increase is so noted in our new budget.

Last major change is possibility of removing the Porti Potty, which is now costing us around \$100

FLYING FIELD RULES

- 1. Safety First: all applicable AMA safety rules apply.
- 2. All flying members must have an AMA membership (insurance)
- 3. Spectators must remain behind the safety fence at all times.
- 4. All non 2.4GHz transmitters must have frequency ID tags.
- 5. The frequency control board will be utilized by all non-2.4GHz flyers.
- 6. No flying will be done west of the pilot line, over the pits, spectator area or parking lot.
- 7. Pilots must stand at a pad except when taking off or landing.
- Announce your intentions before walking from the pilot stations, taking off or landing or emergency situations.
- Minimize your time east of the pilot stations and in the flight area in the event you must be on the runway or on the flight line.
- Starting and running up of engines should be done outside of the pit area and with aircraft restrained.
- 11. All engines 0.10ci and over must have an engine muffler.
- 12. Aircraft must not be taxied in the pit area or toward any person
- 13. Pre-flight check of all aircraft before take off.
